Central Escarpment Cuboree: Offers of Service Welcome Package

Arrival (Weekend):

Upon arrival, please register at the Registration table before setting up your camp. This is where you will receive your camp crest and camp necker. Payment is required upon arrival, if still owing. The cost is \$10 per person. Arrival time is after 5:00 pm on June 9.

Departure (Weekend):

Upon departure, please take all your garbage with you and clean up your site. You will need to get your site checked by a member of the Security Team. When you get the OK, you are free to leave and thank you for your help. Departure time is before 12:00 pm on June 11.

Arrivals (Day Only):

Upon arrival, please register at the Registration table. This is where you will receive your camp crest, camp necker, and wristband. Payment is required upon arrival, if still owing. The cost is \$5 per person. Arrival time is before 8:30 am on June 10. No lunch is provided, please bring your own.

Departures (Day):

Upon departure, please sign out at Security Head Quarters before leaving. All Day Offers of Service's must be departed from the camp before 10:00 pm on June 10.

Camping:

All Offers Of Service are to be camping in the OOS Subcamp and are free to camp anywhere in the designated OOS Subcamp.

Food:

No food is supplied by the camp. Please arrange for your own meals. There are 2 options or food. Either arrange to have your meals with a Cub group in attendance, or cook your own food. If you are coming for the Day, please bring a lunch with you.

Cooking:

Any Offers Of Service's cooking their own food are to dispose of all their garbage properly. Cooking must not be done near tents to reduce the fire hazard. Propane only for cooking fuel.

Garbage:

The camp does not have garbage disposal facilities. Each OOS and Group is responsible for managing their own garbage collection. All garbage must be removed from the camp by the producer of said garbage.

Camp Neckers:

OOS Camp Necker must be worn at all times. If you lose your necker, please go to Security Head Quarters ASAP. Anyone without their necker will be asked to put it on.

Activities for OOS:

Activities for Offers of Service's will be held on Friday and Saturday evenings. Friday night will be a movie night and Saturday will consist of some activities and a game for OOS. Saturday night will also include a *Just Dance* night.

Washrooms:

Portable toilets and outhouses are located throughout the camp. Please let the Offer Of Service you are working with know you are going to the washroom.

Hydration:

Please keep hydrated as much as possible. Drink lots of water and Security Personnel will be around with water bottles if you need more during activity times.

Charging Station:

During the camp, Security Head Quarters will have a charging station set up for all Offers of Service to use. Please do not leave your electronics unattended at the charging station. Cuboree is not responsible for any lost or stolen electronics.

Coffee and Tea:

Coffee and tea will be available to all Offers of Service and Scouters at Security Head Quarters. Please bring your own mug.

Offers Of Service Subcamp:

Offers Of Service will have their own subcamp separate from the youth subcamps. No youth are to be allowed into OOS Subcamp. Please respect everyone around you and keep noise levels to a minimal during quiet hours. Also, remember there is youth around who look up to you as a role model. Scouts Canada's B.P.&P. will be enforced.

Activity Assignment:

As there are many activities which need people to run them, each Offer Of Service will find out which activity they are running upon registration at the camp either Friday Night or Saturday Morning. Please select the top 3 activities you would like to run when you register. We cannot guarantee you will get the activity you would like, but each activity is fun for all to participate in and run.

Activities:

Thank you for taking your time to help run some activities for the youth. Please be at the activity you are helping with 15-20 minutes before activities begin (activities begin at 9:00 am). The Offers of Service's running the activities are responsible for setting up, at the beginning, and cleaning up, at the end, the activity they are helping with. Instructions and supplies for each activity will be provided at the camp. There will be an hour break, between 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm for lunch. Please be back to your activity about 12:50 pm as groups will begin to circulate again.

If you are available to assist in setting up the activities during the day on June 8th or 9th please let us know.

Points for Activities:

Teams competing in each activity earn points for their Subcamp. It is the responsibility of the Offers of Service's running each activity to record which Subcamp each group is with to keep track of points. Tracking sheet provide. If additional sheets needed, please see Security Head Quarters.

Lost and Found:

If there are any items left behind at your activity, please give them to a Security Personnel or please bring them to Security Head Quarters when you have a chance. If you lose something, please go to Security Head Quarters to see if it has been returned.
